CAMP Scholars Program:

The CAMP Scholars program supports UCSB undergraduates from underrepresented groups in science, technology, engineering and mathematics to successfully graduate and further their education beyond the baccalaureate.

Scholar Awards:

Scholars are eligible to apply for the following support:

- GRE Preparation and Exam scholarship
- Graduate School Application award
- Graduate School Visit Travel award
- Travel to Conferences

In addition, Scholars receive information about research internship opportunities and are invited to professional development workshops, student study sessions, and seminars sponsored by the Materials Research Laboratory.

Student Eligibility:

This program is open to any science, engineering, or mathematics undergraduate student who meets the following requirements:

- Enrolled UCSB undergraduate student
- US citizen or permanent resident
- In good academic standing
- Student identifies as one or more underrepresented group: Blacks/African American, Native American/Alaskan Native, Pacific Islander, and Latino/Latina/Hispanic (*The* groups identified as under-represented in STEM are defined by the National Science Foundation LSAMP program and not by the program administrator).

Application Process:

- 1. Completed application form (attached)
- 2. Unofficial Transcripts
- 3. Statement of Interest: Please submit a one-page written statement explaining why you are interested in participating in the program, your long-term goals, and how the program will assist you in accomplishing your goals.
